
Finally. what brilliant 'mad hair' we have seen today! Thank you for supporting this PTFA event, it is much appreciated.

We have lots of second hand uniform including some winter coats. Please pop into the office if you need anything. We just ask for a small donation for any items. except blazers that are priced at £5.




# PTFA NEWS





